In the advisory section.

Writing and Distribution of (4) Sermon Titles for Friday Prayers in the Two National Languages of the Country:

. The Characteristics of a True Muslim Family, dated 6/7/1403

1. Confirming the Qibla direction of the mosque at the Judicial Complex in District 7, dated 7/7/1403

2. Confirming the Qibla direction of the Mosque of Hazrat Umar Farooq (RA) in District 18, dated 9/7/1403

3. Confirming the Qibla direction of the mosque at the Military Administration in District 9, dated 10/7/1403

4. Confirming the Qibla direction of the Mosque of Hazrat Ali (RA) in District 8, dated 12/7/1403

5. Confirming the Qibla direction of the Mosque of Hazrat Bilal in District 5, dated 25/7/1403

6. Confirming the Qibla direction of the Mosque of Khātam an-Nabiyyīn in District 13, dated 25/7/1403.

Reviewing the Permanent Schedule for the Five Daily Prayers and Sending it to the Publication Department for Printing.

Monitoring Mosques: Overseeing and supervising (cleanliness, order, study circles, guidance programs, electricity and water expenses, active personnel attendance, preventing unauthorized and suspicious individuals, etc.) in a total of (2360) mosque pulpits in Kabul.

Resolving Disputes and Issues Among Community Members: Addressing problems involving Imams, Muezzins, and caretakers in (43) mosque pulpits.

Equipping Mosques with Loudspeakers and Carpets: Through proposal number (712) dated 29/1/1446 AH, submitted to the esteemed Ministry of Guidance, Hajj, and Religious Affairs for equipping mosques with carpets and loudspeakers. This has been approved, and subsequent activities are ongoing.

Payment of Electricity Bills: Through proposal number (20) dated 25/1/1446 AH for settling outstanding electricity bills for mosques submitted to the esteemed Ministry of MOHIA. This has been approved, and further activities are ongoing

An examination was conducted for scholars for their employment in vacant Imam positions, which, after the processes of appointment, dismissal, and transfer of Imams, Muezzins, and caretakers, reached a total of (90) individuals and was sent to the Human Resources Directorate.
Special control and supervision of the Sharif Pul Khishti Mosque for organizing electricity, cleaning, resolving issues in the ablution areas, and other necessary matters.

• The electricity issues of (13) prayer niches in various districts of Kabul have been addressed, and timely actions have been taken to illuminate the mosques.

• Drilling deep wells in mosques is currently underway for administrative and operational matters.

• Organizing and coordinating the reciters and memorization circles in mosques.

• Renewal of activity licenses: One activity license for a study circle has been renewed and registered.

• Registration of study circles: Control, supervision, and review of (15) study circles for memorization and recitation of the Holy Quran in mosques that have requested registration.

• Distribution of licenses: Distribution and issuance of (10) activity licenses to newly established schools and circles.

• Curriculum and teaching methods: Distribution of curriculum and teaching methods to newly registered circles.

• Examination of students at the institute: Conducting exams for twenty percent of the second and fourth semester students in grades 13 and 14 at the Higher Institute of Recitation.

• Supervision of the funeral reading process: Control and review of the funeral reading process in (9) prayer niches across twenty-two districts of Kabul city.

• A database has been created for (15) prayer niches, mosques, and community centers.

• Supervision and control of (29) prayer niches, mosques, and community centers by mosque officials and workers.

• An agreement with the Breshna Company regarding electricity consumption for (9) prayer niches.

Religious Education:

• The second round of the Imam Training Program for (80) trainees, including scholars, speakers, and current Imams of mosques in Kabul city, was inaugurated by respected Sheikh al-Hadith Mawlawi Zarmohammad "Haqani," the Deputy for Professional Affairs of the Ministry of MOHIA, at the headquarters of the Religious Education and Imam Training Directorate located on Airport Road in Kabul.

• Extension of activity licenses for (4) schools in the areas of Kabul city as follows:

• Issuance of activity licenses for (4) schools and Quran memorization centers in the provinces of Balkh.

• Supervision of (4) schools for obtaining licenses:

• Monitoring the operational processes of (8) registered schools and private Quran memorization centers under the Directorate of Guidance, Hajj, and Religious Endowments in Laghman province by the managers of Religious Education and Imam Training.

• Extension of activity licenses for (3) schools in the provinces of Balkh as follows:

• Supervision of the final exam for (345) graduates from various religious sciences sections in schools in the central areas {of Kabul}.

• Graduation of (54) individuals in District (5).

• Graduation of (56) individuals in District (8).

• Graduation of (91) individuals in District (22)

• Holding a graduation ceremony for (2131) graduates from various religious sciences from Al-Falah School in District 8 of Kabul city.

• Graduation of (56) individuals in District (8).

Administrative Section:

• A total of (27) requests from various provinces, aimed at the construction of mosques, were referred to assisting organizations.

• The documents of a pilgrim who sustained severe injuries in a traffic accident during the Hajj ceremony in the year 1445 in Medina and later died from those injuries in Afghanistan were referred to the esteemed Ministry of Foreign Affairs for legal follow-up

• The documents related to the visit of the esteemed Mufti Sheikh Nuruddin, the respected head of the Muslim Community of Uzbekistan, who arrived in the country at the official invitation of the honorable Minister, were followed up at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and necessary actions were taken in this regard.

• Follow-up on the travel documents of an assistant minister and their accompanying delegation with the esteemed Ministry of Foreign Affairs for participation in a conference on religion in Turkey.

• Discussions were held with employees of the esteemed Hope Eye (COCO) organization regarding technical issues related to drilling clean water wells in mosques in Kabul city, and two meetings were also conducted on this matter.

• Drafting and signing the text of a memorandum of understanding with the esteemed Hope Eye (COCO) organization.

• Introduction of a project to drill five wells in mosques and schools under the Directorate of Hajj and Religious Endowments in Kunduz province.

• Follow-up on the documents related to the remaining construction work of a mosque's mihrab that was built by the Turkish organization (IHH) in the Qarghayi district of Laghman province.

Policy and Plan:

• Finalization of the procedures for the Institute of Religious Education and Imam Training in the Legislative Documents Committee of the Ministry

• Preparation of the procedures for the Technology and Information Directorate for review and finalization in the Legislative Documents Committee of the Ministry.

• Collection, evaluation, and consolidation of the plan for the year 1404 from 24 provinces.

• Collection, evaluation, and consolidation of the plan for the year 1404 from central directorates.

• Submission of a draft proposal for the use of domestic products to the Facilitation and Investment Directorate, Policy Deputy of the Emirate, and the esteemed General Administration of Affairs.

• Providing feedback on the proposal to attract and encourage foreign investors to the Economic

Deputy of the Prime Minister's Office.

• Collection of statistics for the second quarter of the fiscal year 1403 from (7) central directorates and submission to the esteemed National Statistics Office.
